04- MY FRIEND

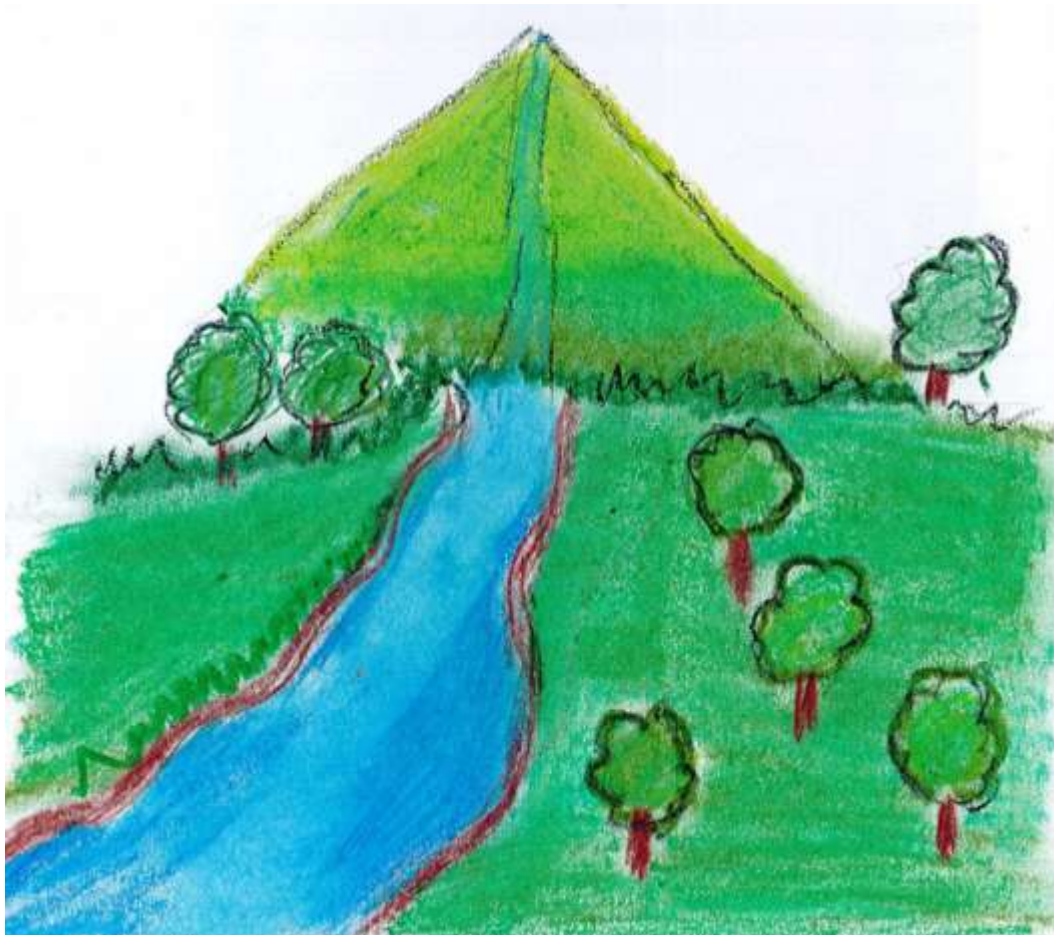
When I am in trouble or

06- FROGS IN THE POND

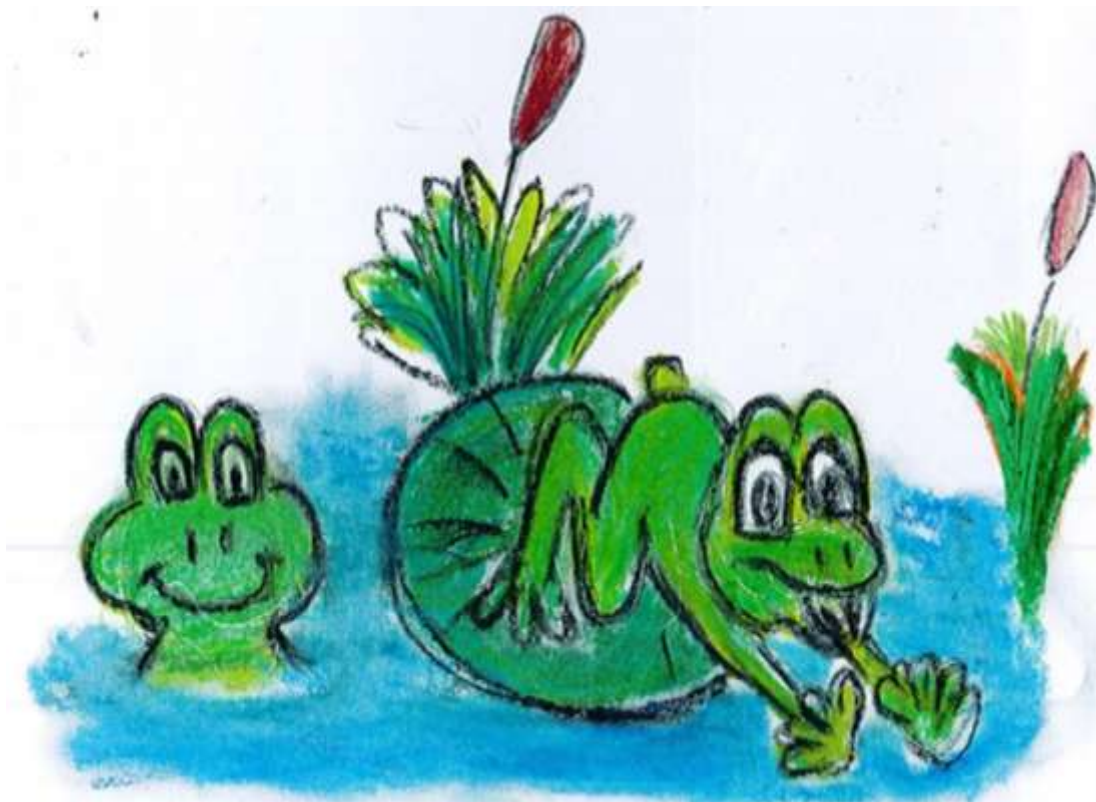
Frog sin the pond say

One two three

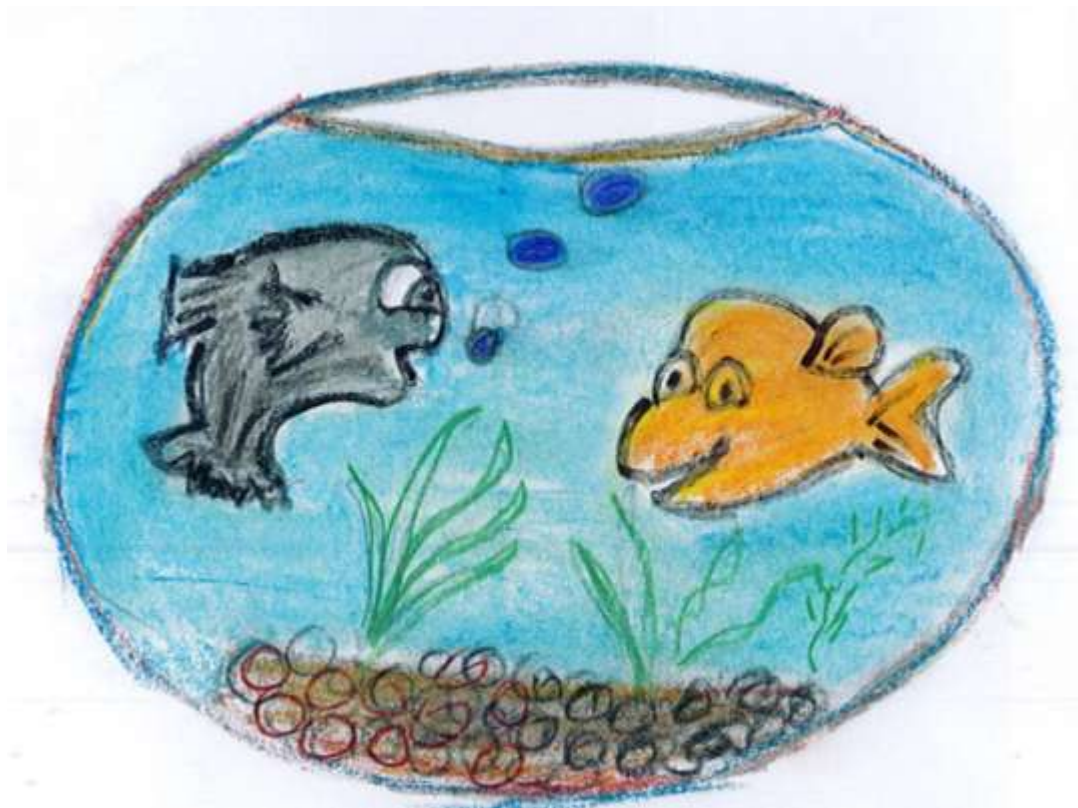
It's a golden fish

We love it as our parents

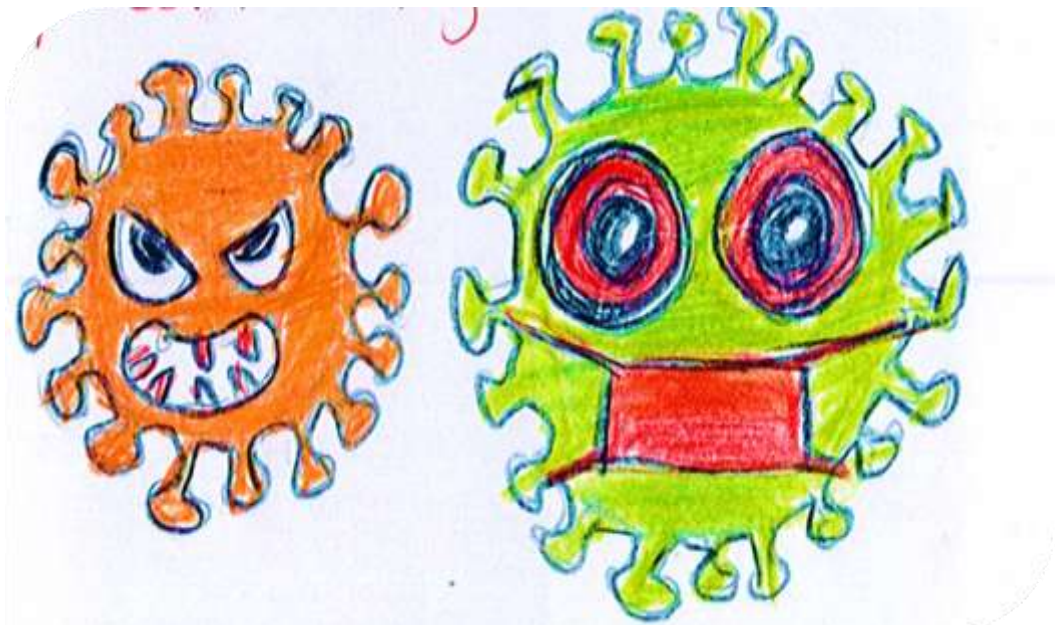
And it is the place that we learn.

How my grandmothers look after my parents the best way...

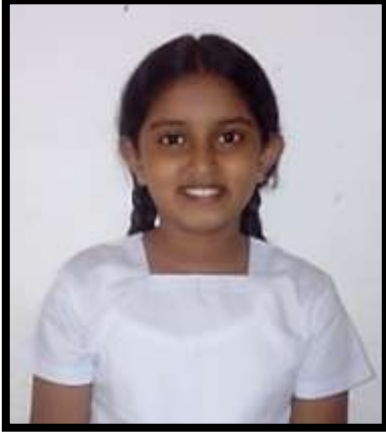
She teaches me what's good and bad
