As they were watching TV mom said “Breakfast is ready.....”

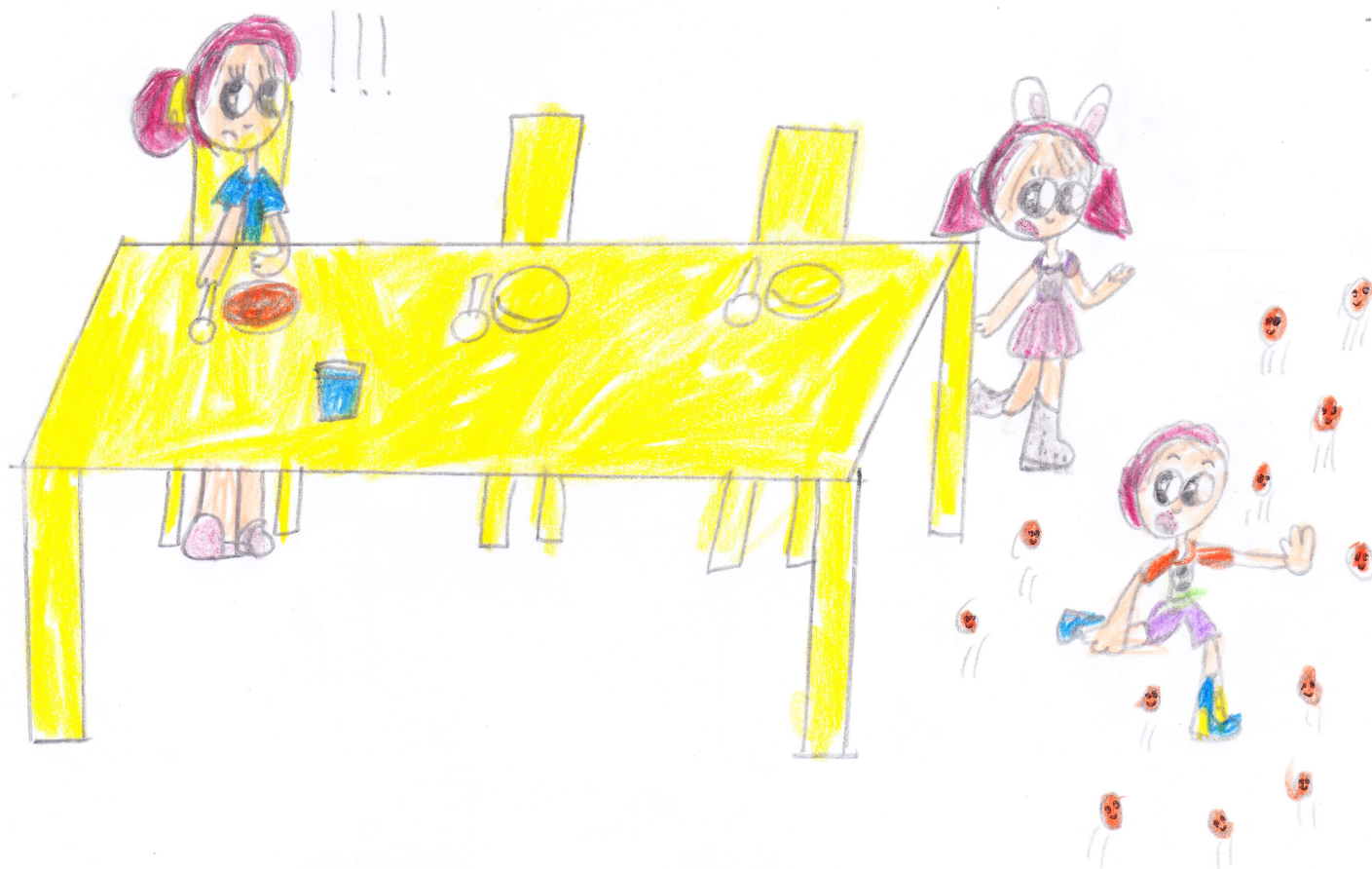
They rushed to the dining room.

They came closer and they thought that the beans wanted to be friends.

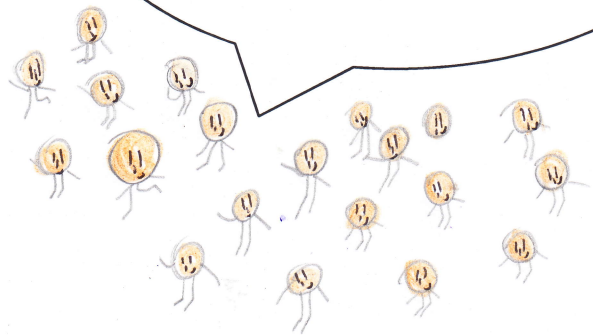
So they were now friends and live happily ever after.
