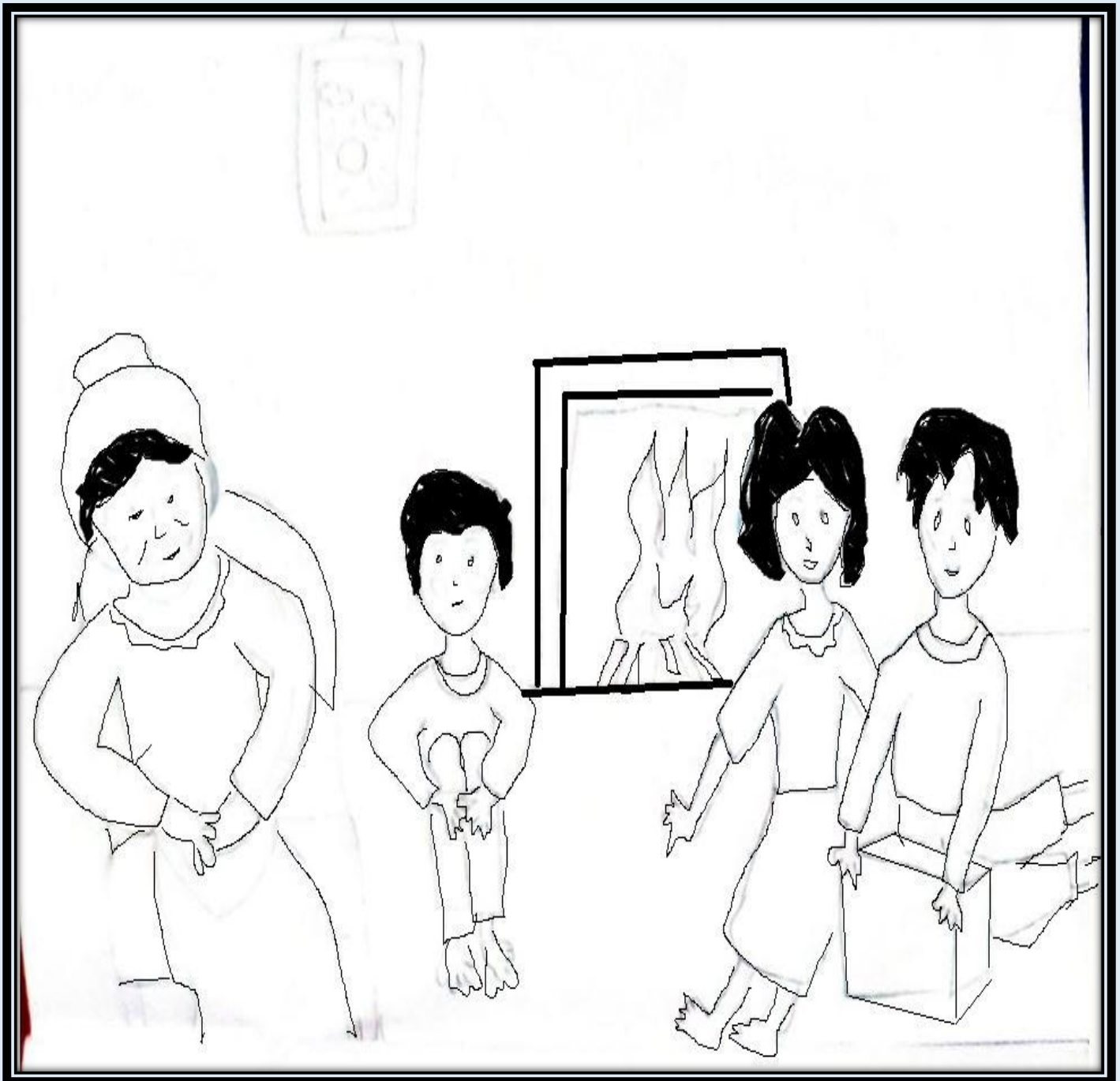

nest within a day and all the children must do it with support from friends or siblings.

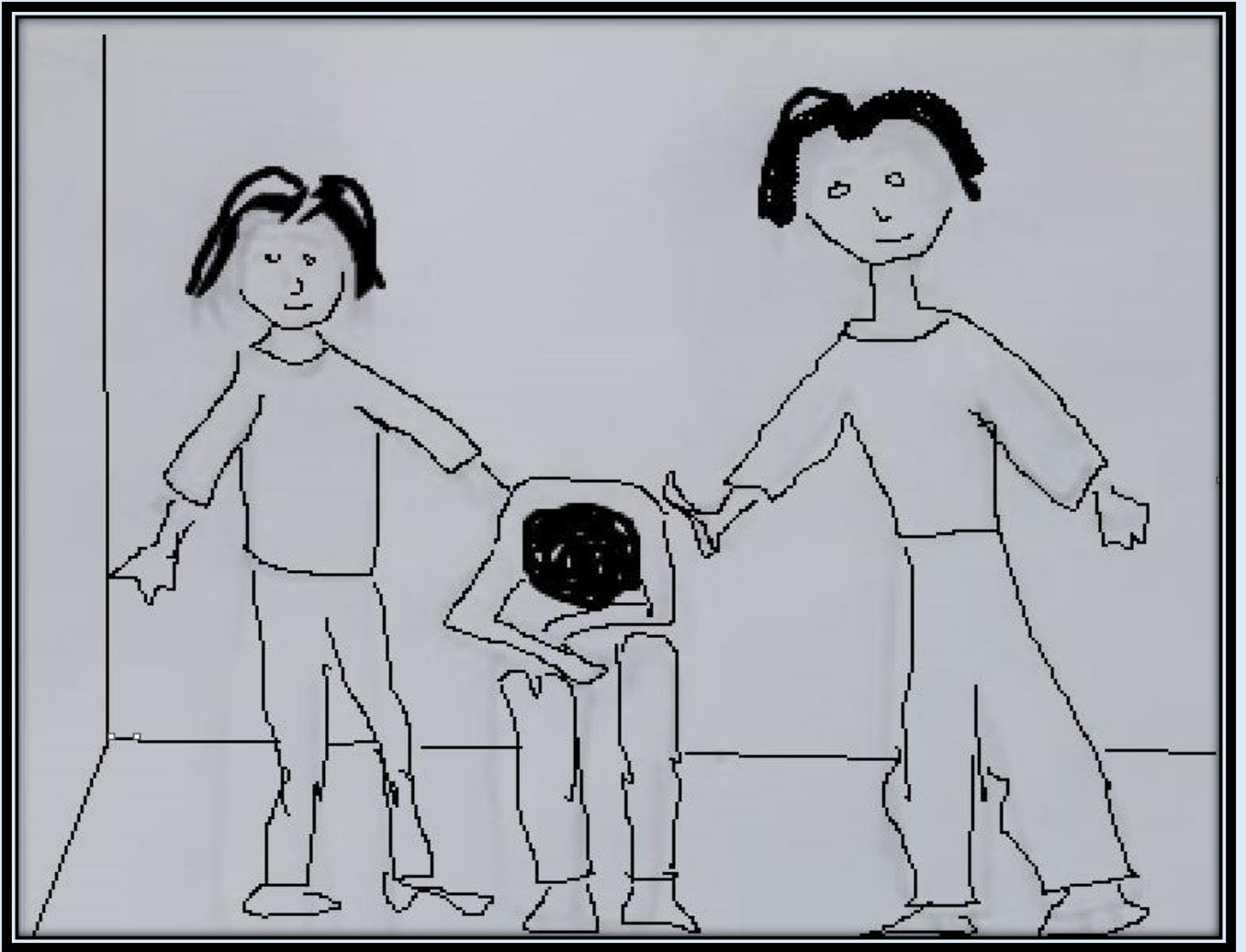

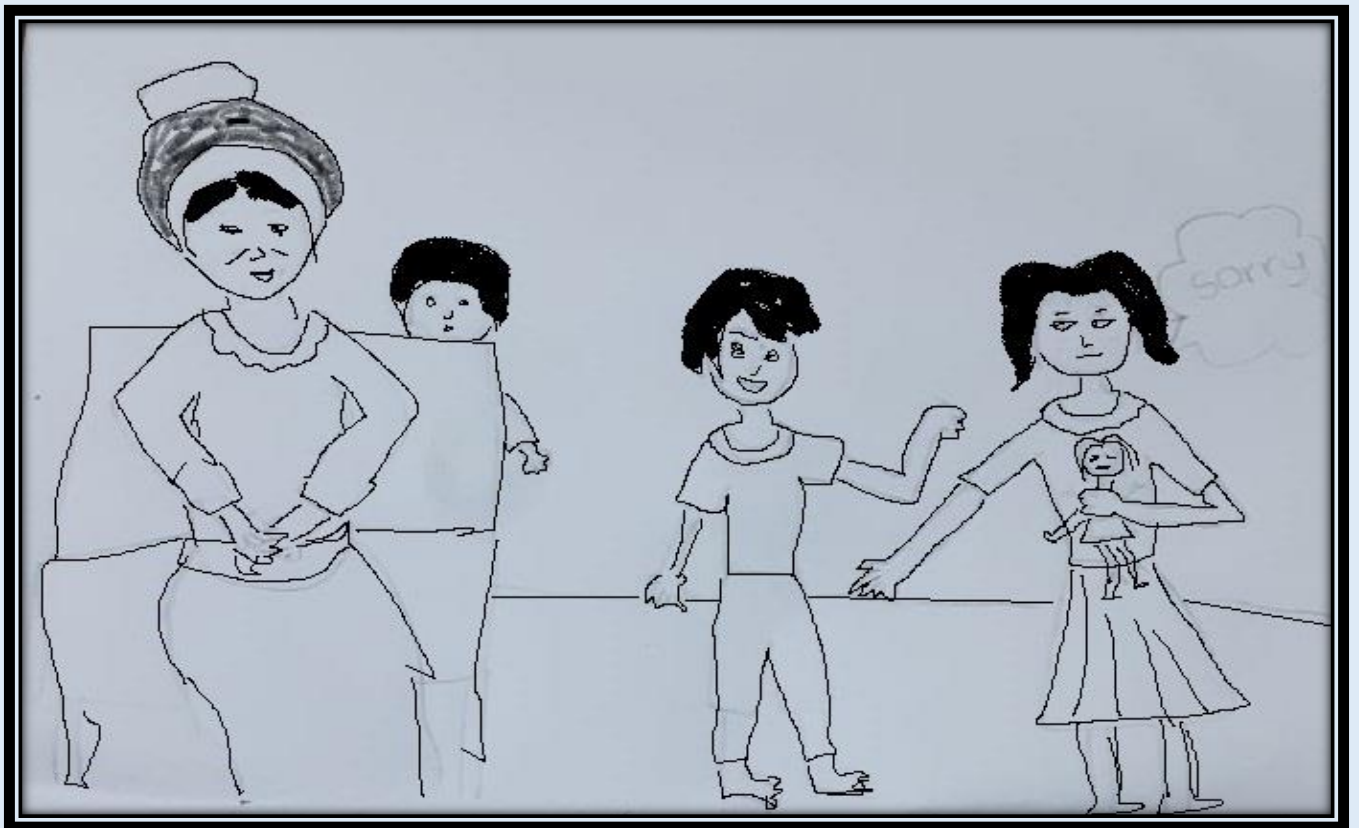

“Sorry Peter” Martha said in low voice.

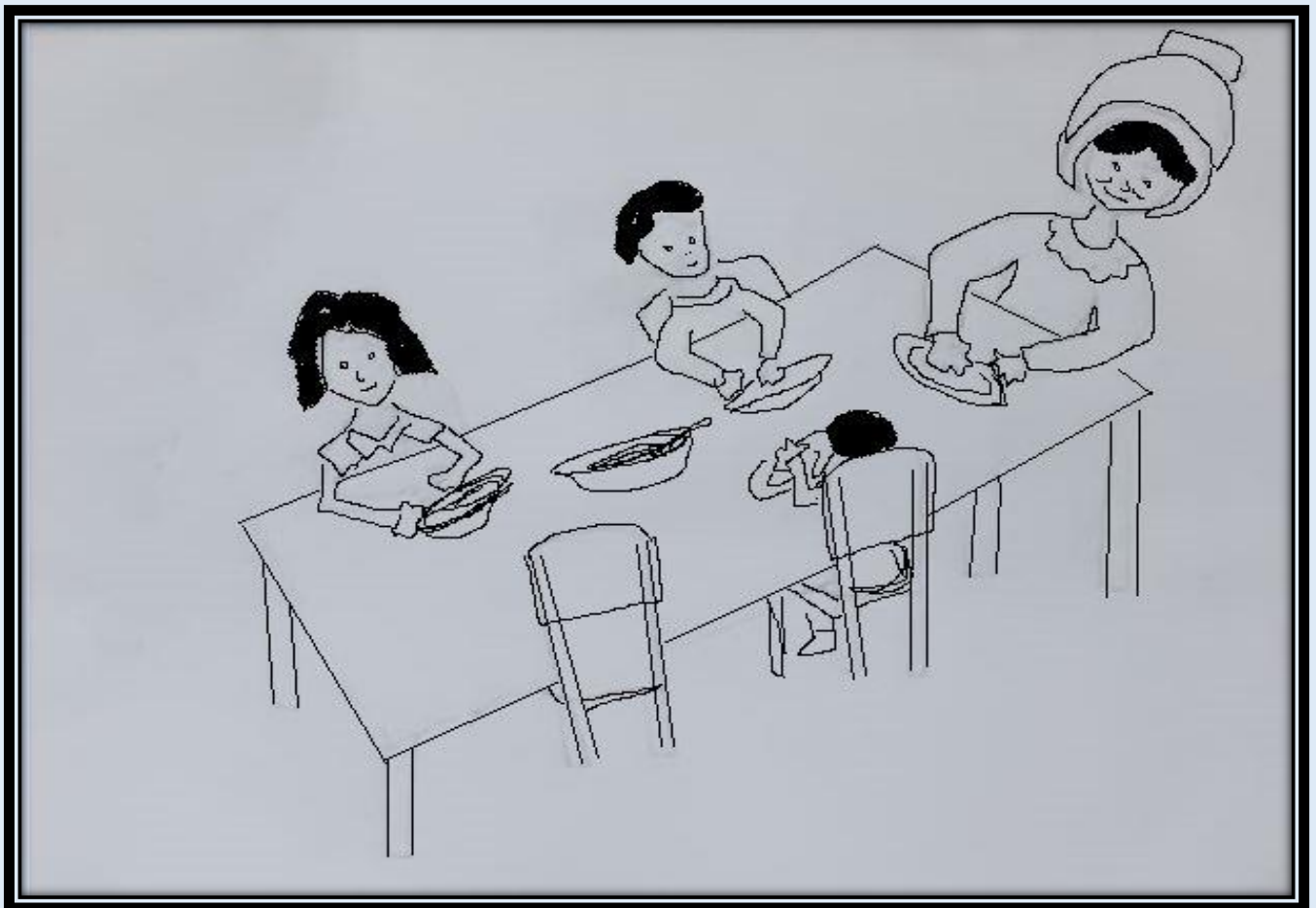


“It is fine. We will build a tower taller than the previous one, together” said Peter in a joyful voice.

“but I'm hungry” Little John complained again.

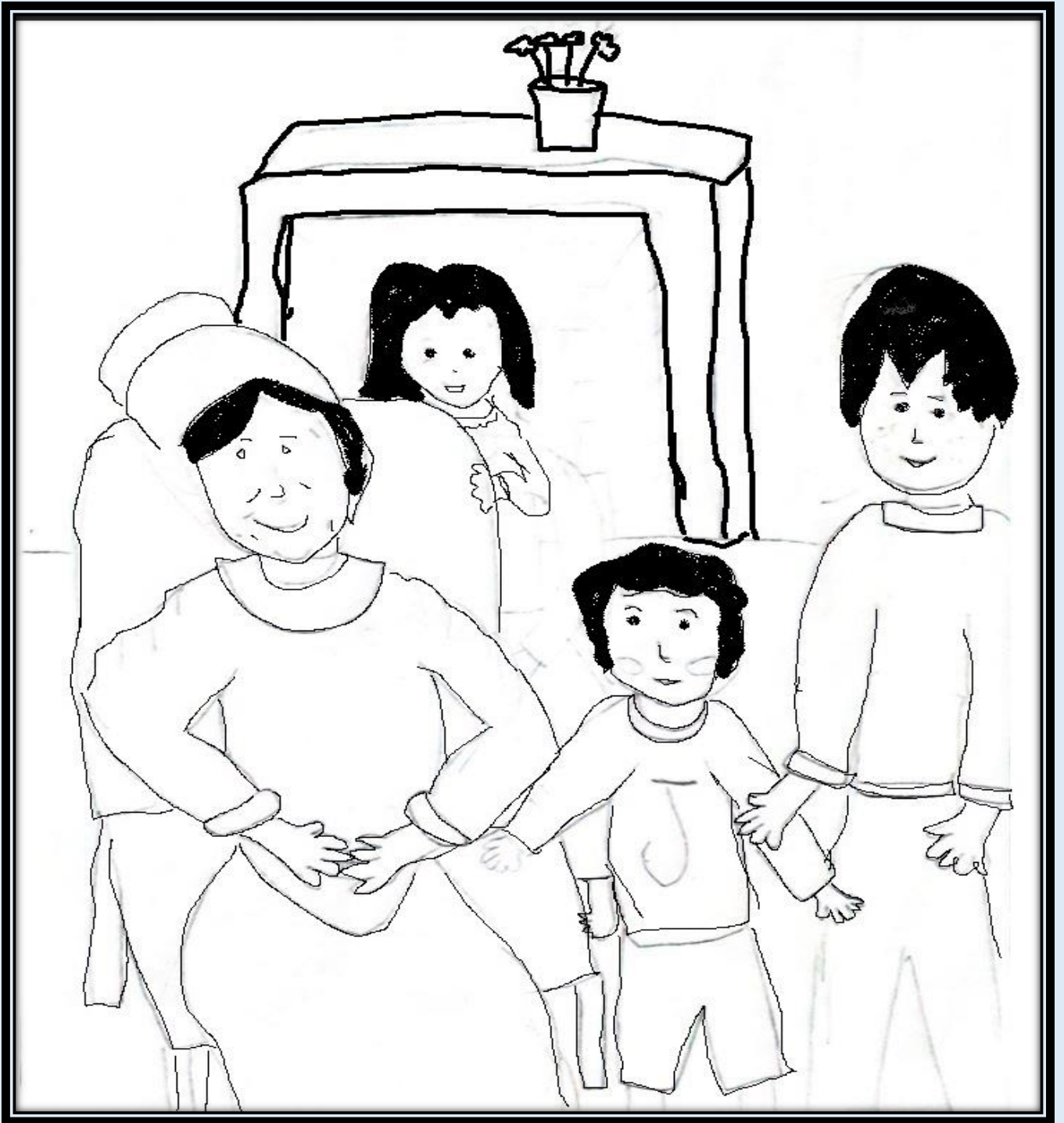
“Children come. The breakfast is ready” mom commented.

“Thanks God” said John and ran to the kitchen. He was too short to sit in the chair, so grandmother kept him on a chair.



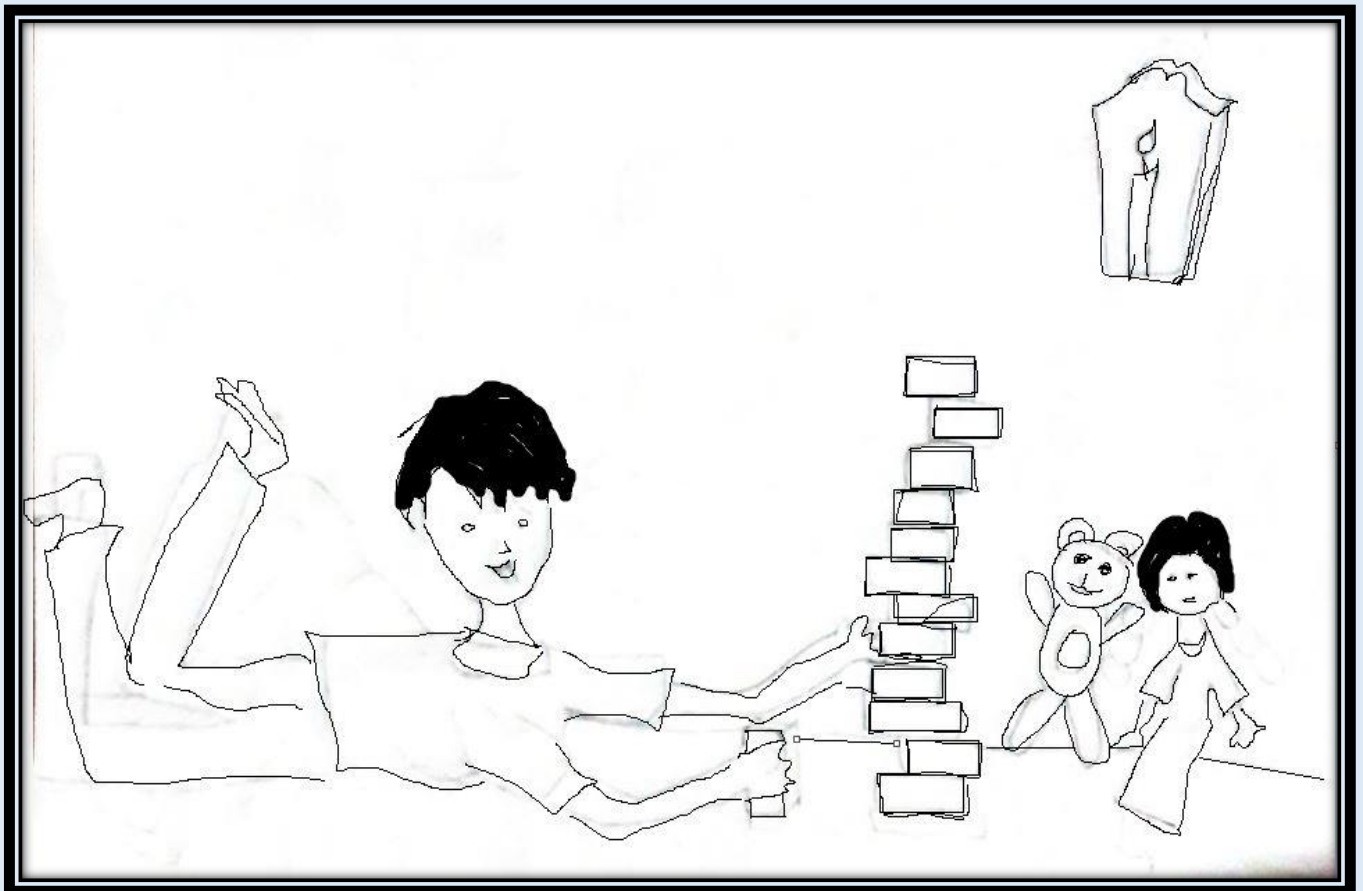
“Isn't father coming mom?” asked Peter.
