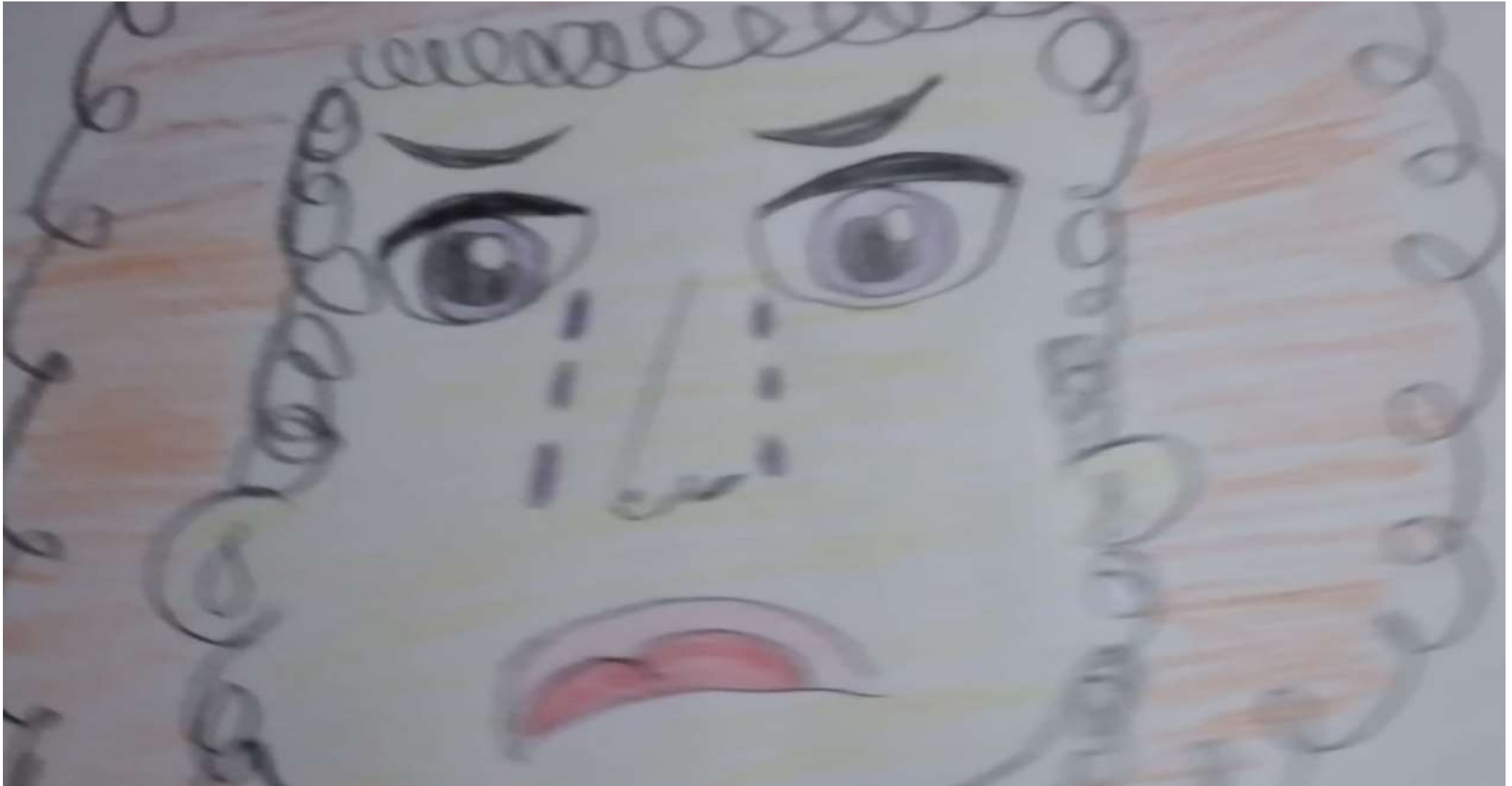

And every plant will die now” the woman said “no! no! no! what am I doing “cried the woman so sadly . One tear felled in to the ground a beautiful plant apeard.



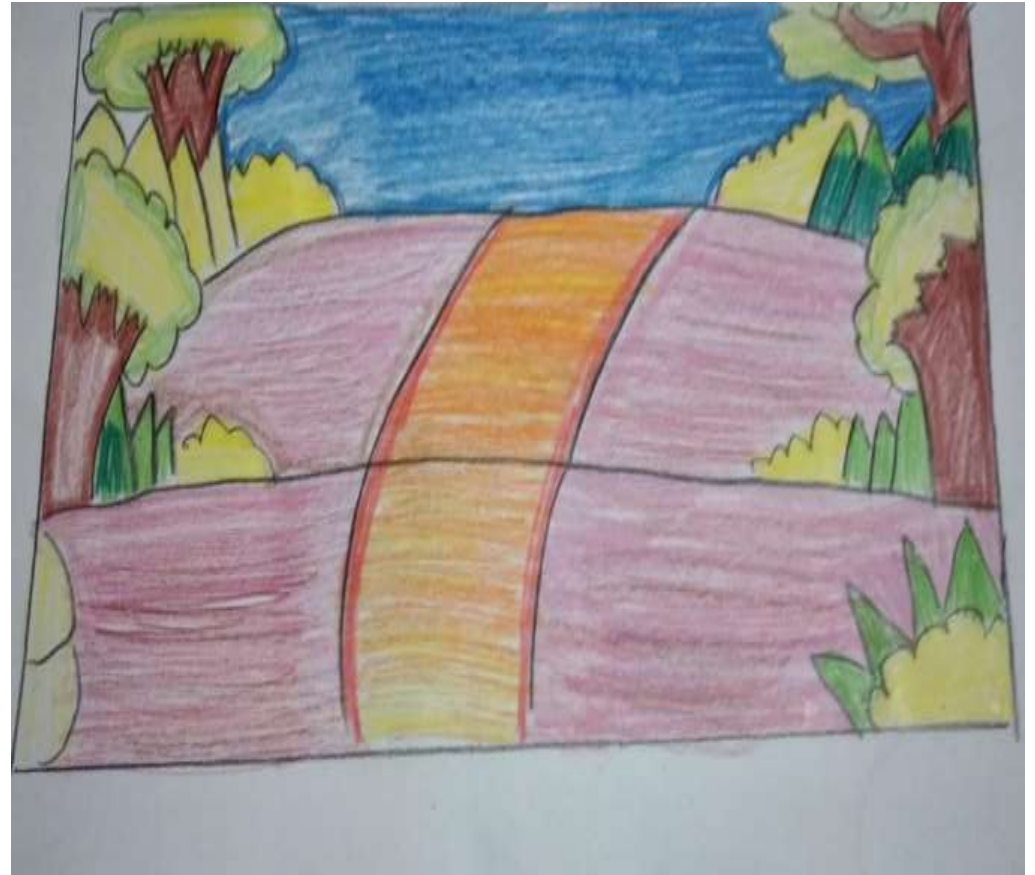
