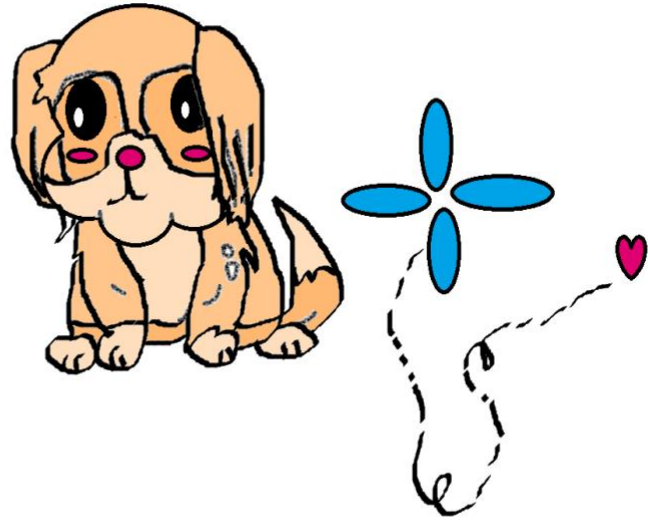
But because of Alex's wish and the little dogs luck one person
