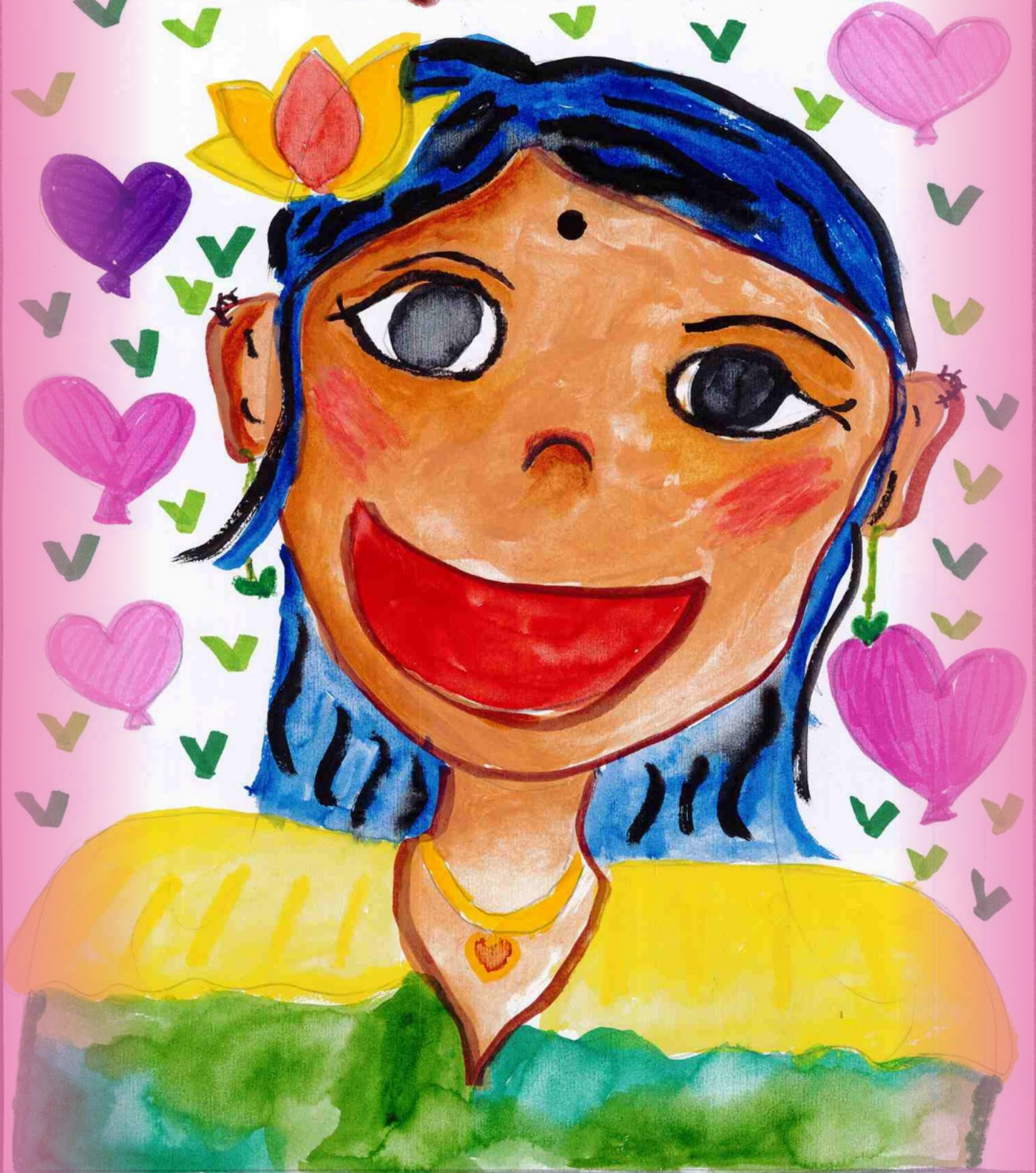

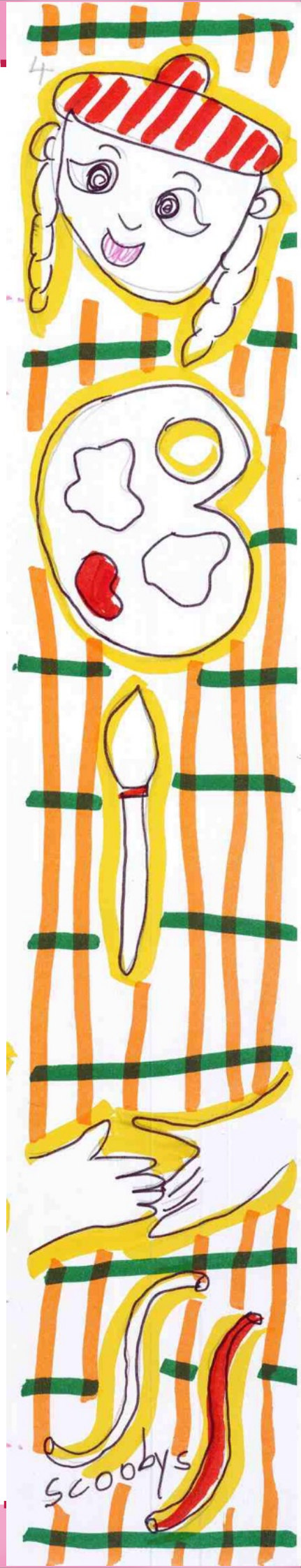
03. Sithumi
