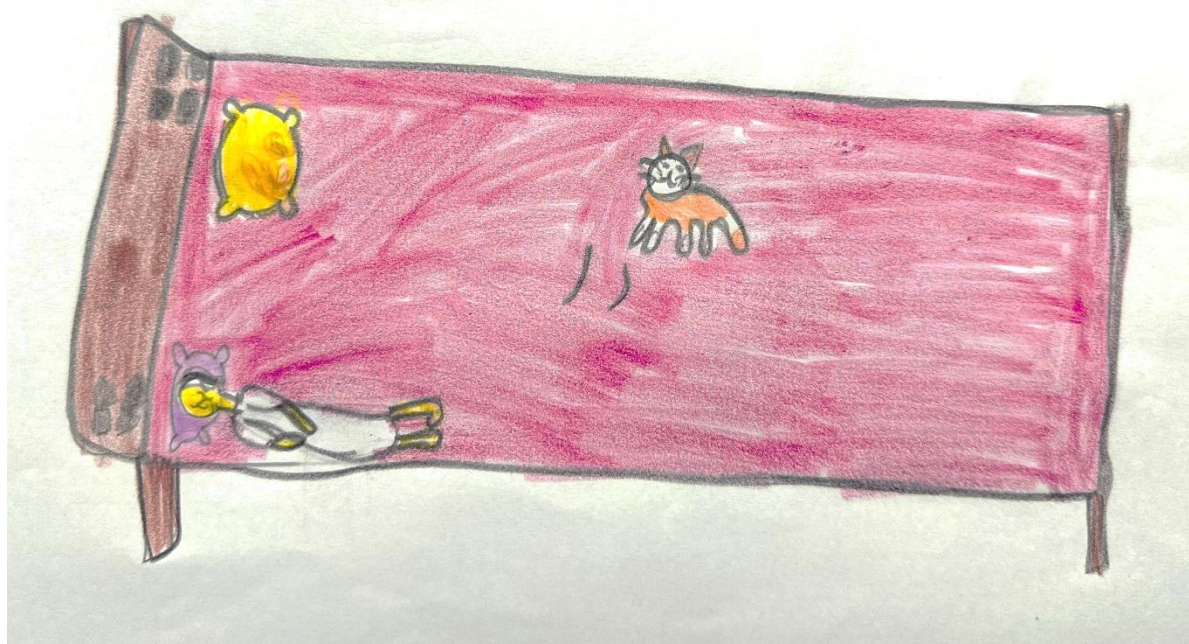
The Pirivena student monks have also taken up book writing “The Herana Gatkarani “ project was introduced.
