The sky was filled with colorful clouds, birds, kites and some were fairies with their pet unicorns.

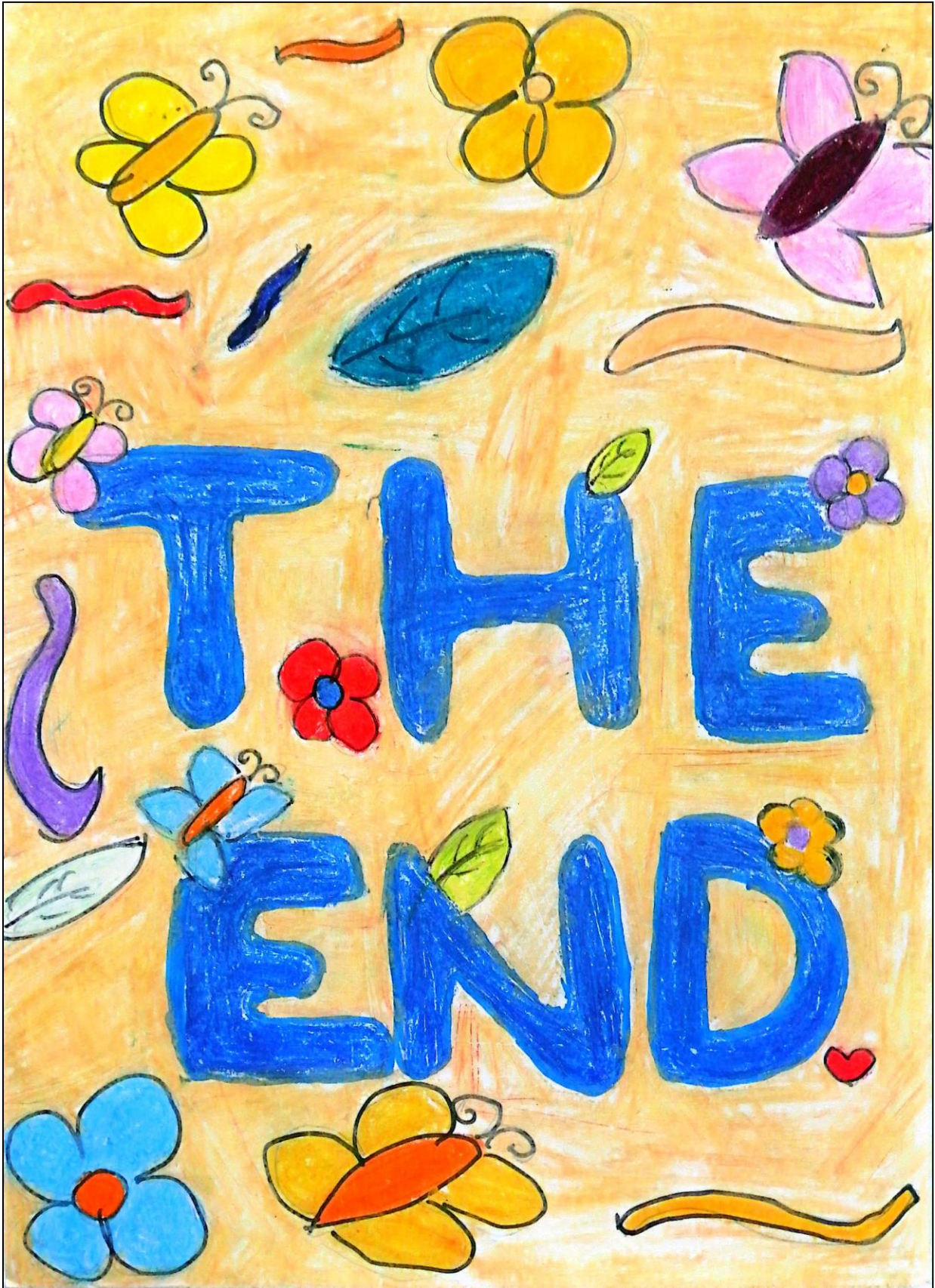


They played for hours, and they all heard, their mothers calling
